ORDINANCE NUMBER 211

An Ordinance by the Council of the Borough of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania amending Chapter 21, Part 1 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Street Occupancy", by adding new §21- 110 R. requiring that all street paving materials and street specifications shall follow the most recent Pennsylvania Department of Transportation requirements as follows:

1. By inserting §21-110.R. after §21-110.Q.as follows:


"R. Most Recent PennDot Requirements to be Used. Whenever reference is made to paving materials or specifications for the repair or construction of streets in this Ordinance, whether such reference is to Borough requirements or PennDot requirements, the most recently published PennDot paving materials and street paving construction specifications shall be used and shall supercede all other references to such paving materials and street paving construction specifications in this Ordinance.

2. Except as modified by this Ordinance, the remainder of Chapter 21, Part 1 shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
3. This Ordinance is hereby incorporated into Part 21, Part 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Honey Brook.


This Ordinance shall become effective on the date which is 5 days after its adoption.
