

**BOROUGH OF HONEY BROOK**

**ORDINANCE NUMBER** 218

An Ordinance by the Council of the Borough of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania amending Chapter 20, Part 1 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Solid Waste" by amending Section 20-106.A. "Multifamily units and nonresidential units" and Section 20-118 "Violations and penalties" as follows:

1. By deleting §20-106.A. and inserting the following in its place:

"A. Each person who owns or occupies a multifamily unit within a building containing 4 or more residential units or a nonresidential unit shall provide proper on-site collection and disposal for regulated municipal waste and designated recyclable materials by utilizing an adequately sized dumpster for regulated municipal waste and a recycling container for designated recyclable materials in compliance with Borough requirements and a permitted collector to collect and deliver such materials to a facility. Borough Council may approve an alternative method of storage for regulated municipal waste in the event it is demonstrated that it is not possible to utilize a dumpster on-site. With respect to municipal contract waste and designated recyclable materials, a person who owns a multifamily unit containing more than four residential units or nonresidential unit may request Borough approval to receive the services under the Municipal Contract. The Borough shall determine whether to approve such request at its sole discretion. "

2. By deleting §20-118 and inserting the following in its place:

**"§ 20-118. Violations and penalties.**


Any person violating any provision of this chapter or any provision of the Borough's Policies and Procedures shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be liable to pay a fine or penalty of not more than \$1,000 plus costs of prosecution or shall undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days. Each violation of any provision of this chapter or of any provision of the Borough's Policies and Procedures, and each day that such a violation continues, shall constitute a separate violation and offense."

3. Except as modified by this Ordinance, the remainder of Chapter 5, Part 2 shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
- 4.. This Ordinance is hereby incorporated into Part 20, Part 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Honey Brook.


This Ordinance shall become effective on the date which is 5 days after its adoption.


