ORDINANCE NUMBER 225

An Ordinance by the Council of the Borough of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania amending Chapter 27 of the Code of Ordinances, "Zoning", Part 10 "Supplemental Use Regulations" by amending Section 27-1002 "Accessory Uses, Buildings and Structures", Section 3.A. "Residential Accessory Uses, Buildings or Structures, paragraph (3) (c)" as follows:

1. By deleting §27-1002 (3) (c) and inserting the following in its place:

"(c). Swimming pools and buildings related to the pool may be located in the rear or side yard of the lot and shall not be closer than 10 feet to a lot line. Any paved areas or decks related to the pool shall not be closer than 5 feet to a lot line.


2. Except as modified by this Ordinance, the remainder of Chapter 27, Part 10 shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

3. This Ordinance is hereby incorporated into Part 27, Part 10 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Honey Brook.


This Ordinance shall become effective on the date which is 5 days after its adoption.
