

BOROUGH OF HONEY BROOK
ORDINANCE NUMBER 226

An Ordinance by the Council of the Borough of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania amending Chapter 21 of the Code of Ordinances, "Streets and Sidewalks", Part 2 A. "Sidewalk Construction and Maintenance" by deleting current Section 21-207 "Snow Removal" and replacing Section 21-207 with a new Section 21- 207 "Obstructions to be Removed from Sidewalks" as follows:

1. By deleting current Section 21-207 and inserting the following Section 21-207 in its place:

§21-207. Obstructions to be Removed from Sidewalks

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, occupying or having charge or control of any premises, to impede, place or cause to be placed, or suffer to remain upon the sidewalk, any obstruction, including vehicles, equipment, fences, structures, cones, signs, waste, waste containers, building materials, construction debris, vending machines, newspaper racks, or any other objects that are placed, parked, planted, left or erected on, in, upon, or over a pedestrian way except as otherwise authorized by statute or ordinance, and except to the extent required by the performance of some function authorized or mandated by statute, ordinance, or public safety.


2. Except as modified by this Ordinance, the remainder of Chapter 21, Part A shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

3. This Ordinance is hereby incorporated into Chapter 21, Part 2A of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Honey Brook.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the date which is 5 days after its adoption.
