ORDINANCE NUMBER 228

An Ordinance by the Council of the Borough of Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania amending Chapter 1 of the Code of Ordinances, "Administration and Government", Part 2A "Tax Collector" by amending the compensation of the elected tax collector as follows:

1. Section 1-201 of Part 2 "Compensation", Subsection 1. is hereby amended by inserting the following sentence at the end thereof:


"In the event a deputy Tax Collector shall collect the real estate taxes levied by Honey Brook Borough, the elected Tax Collector shall not be entitled to receive the aforementioned commission of 4% but shall instead receive an annual salary of \$1.00. "

2. Except as modified by this Ordinance, the remainder of Chapter 1, Part 2A shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
3. This Ordinance is hereby incorporated into Chapter 1, Part 2A of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Honey Brook.


This Ordinance shall become effective on the date which is 5 days after its adoption.
